

## PLANTATION ARTISTS' GUILD & GALLERY BOARD MINUTES

Tuesday, April 6, 2021

**Members and Standing Committee Chairs Present:** Ginger Bender, Karen Bowden, Sherry Ferber, Cindy Jenkins, Vickie Maley, Rebecca McDannold, Ed Mosher, Brenda Price, Gary Rubin

**Call to Order:** President Sherry Ferber called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm and presented the agenda.

### Officer Reports

**Secretary:** Vickie Maley: Karen Bowden moved to approve the minutes from the March 2, 2021 board meeting. Brenda Price seconded the motion, and the minutes were approved.

**1<sup>st</sup> Vice President: Karen Bowden:** Karen reviewed the final plans for the 2020 Project: A Look Back. The theme will be "Kiss 2020 Good-bye". Artists should take out work they will not be placing in show 49 on Thursday after closing. The next show's new art will be taken in and hung on Monday, April 12.

During the show, the number of people will be monitored. Masks will be required. There is a traffic pattern to be followed. All the photographs will be displayed on easels throughout the gallery on the floor. The magazine will be available for purchase (#25) with all proceeds to Arts Alive!

The show will be open to the public Friday through Sunday (April 9-11) until 5 pm each day. There is a VIP reception on Friday from 5-7 pm.

After some discussion it was agreed not to host a reception for show #49.

Karen said that Vickie Germond is creating a database of customers.

She again reminded artist working the desk that whenever a sale is made from any of the PAGG venues, Karen should be notified so she can remove that art from the online gallery.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President: Ed Mosher** reported all supplies are well stocked. The Osprey Village and AIES rehangs are postponed.

**Treasurer: Cindy Jenkins:** Cindy reported March sales at \$12,520 before taxes and \$11,750 after taxes. Cindy asked the board to think about costs for advertising. Almost all the 3% profit the gallery keeps goes toward advertising.

Cindy discussed management of the record keeping for Art Lovers. There is no process for managing dues payments or renewals. A suggestion was made that the art lovers committee should take the leadership role for that and report the list to the treasurer/finance committee.
